

WHY BIBLE DRILL?

Learning how to navigate, use, and build your life on God's Word

*Bible Drill helps students understand the **basic structure and organization** of Scripture so that they are able to easily navigate God's Word. It helps them begin to **commit to memory** key verses that will help them in forming their understanding of God and His world. It equips them to **answer questions** that they will encounter either personally or from others as they grow. It reinforces **God's Word as the foundation** and standard of all truth.*

What does the Bible say about itself?

Be diligent to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who doesn't need to be ashamed, correctly teaching the word of truth. **2 Timothy 2:15**

Your word is a lamp for my feet and a light on my path. **Psalms 119:105**

How can a young man keep his way pure? By keeping your word. **Psalms 119:9**

All Scripture is inspired by God and is profitable for teaching, for rebuking, for correcting, for training in righteousness, so that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work. **2 Timothy 3:16-17**

SCRIPTURE SEARCHING DRILL

Focus Week: Jan. 28 - Feb. 3

Find & Read (A random verse will be called. Locate the verse in your Bible, place your finger on the verse, and step forward. If called on, read the verse and state the reference. You will NOT have to quote anything from memory.)

The best way to prepare for this drill is to:

1. **Memorize** the books of the Bible.
2. **Practice** finding and locating the **books** of the Bible.
3. Then **practice** finding and locating specific **verses**.

IDENTIFYING VERSES DRILL

Focus Week: Feb. 4 - 10

Memorize, Find, & Read (A portion of the verse will be called. Identify and find the verse in your Bible, place your finger on the verse, and step forward. If called on, read the verse and state the reference. You will NOT have to quote from memory.)

1. "Now if you will carefully listen to me and keep my covenant, you will be my own possession out of all the peoples, although the whole earth is mine," **Exodus 19:5**
2. Trust in him at all times, you people; pour out your hearts before him. God is our refuge. *Selah* **Psalm 62:8**
3. "Instead, this is the covenant I will make with the house of Israel after those days" - the LORD'S declaration. "I will put my teaching within them and write it on their hearts. I will be their God, and they will be my people." **Jeremiah 31:33**
4. Then he said to his disciples: "Therefore I tell you, don't worry about your life, what you will eat; or about the body, what you will wear. For life is more than food and the body more than clothing." **Luke 12:22-23**
5. Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. The one who believes in me, even if he dies, will live." **John 11:25**
6. Therefore, my dear brothers and sisters, be steadfast, immovable, always excelling in the Lord's work, because you know that your labor in the Lord is not in vain. **1 Corinthians 15:58**
7. But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. The law is not against such things. **Galatians 5:22-23**
8. Adopt the same attitude as that of Christ Jesus, who, existing in the form of God, did not consider equality with God as something to be exploited. Instead he emptied himself by assuming the form of a servant, taking on the likeness of humanity. And when he had come as a man, **Philippians 2:5-7**
9. So if you have been raised with Christ, seek the things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things. **Colossians 3:1-2**
10. But since we belong to the day, let us be self-controlled and put on the armor of faith and love, and a helmet of the hope of salvation. For God did not appoint us to wrath, but to obtain salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ, **1 Thessalonians 5:8-9**

DOCTRINAL VERSES DRILL

Focus Week: Feb. 11 - 17

Memorize, Find, & Read (The name of a doctrine will be called. Identify and find the associated verse in your Bible, place your finger on verse, and step forward. If called on, state the doctrine, read the verse, and state the reference. You will NOT have to quote from memory.)

1. **The Lord's Day** - Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy: **Exodus 20:8**
2. **Education** - This is what the LORD, your Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel says: I am the LORD your God, who teaches you for your benefit, who leads you in the way you should go. **Isaiah 48:17**
3. **Last Things** - "This good news of the kingdom will be proclaimed in all the world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come." **Matthew 24:14**
4. **God** - The Word became flesh and dwelt among us. We observed his glory, the glory as the one and only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth. **John 1:14**
5. **Religious Liberty** - Peter and the apostles replied, "We must obey God rather than people." **Acts 5:29**
6. **Evangelism and Missions** - And how can they preach unless they are sent? As it is written: How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news. **Romans 10:15**
7. **Stewardship** - On the first day of the week, each of you is to set something aside and save in keeping with how he is prospering, so that no collections will need to be made when I come. **1 Corinthians 16:28**
8. **The Church** - saying: I will proclaim your name to my brothers and sisters; I will sing hymns to you in the congregation. **Hebrews 2:12**
9. **Grace** - Therefore let us approach the throne of grace with boldness, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in time of need. **Hebrews 4:16**
10. **Scripture** - Above all, you know this: No prophecy of Scripture comes from the prophet's own interpretation, because no prophecy ever came by the will of man; instead, men spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit. **2 Peter 1:20-21**

BIBLE ANSWER DRILL

Focus Weeks: Feb. 18 - 24 (#1-5)

Feb. 25 - Mar. 2 (#6-10)

Memorize, Find, & QUOTE (A question will be asked. Identify and find the answer verse in your Bible, place your finger on verse, and step forward. When instructed, close Bible. If called on, state the question, QUOTE the verse from memory, and state the reference.)

1. **Am I alone?** "Haven't I commanded you: be strong and courageous? Do not be afraid or discouraged, for the LORD your God is with you wherever you go." **Joshua 1:9**
2. **Who should I trust?** Trust in the LORD forever, because in the LORD, the LORD himself, is an everlasting rock! **Isaiah 26:4**
3. **What are the results of seeking good?** Pursue good and not evil so that you may live, and the LORD, the God of Armies, will be with you as you have claimed. **Amos 5:14**
4. **What does Jesus require of me?** Then Jesus said to his disciples, "If anyone wants to follow after me, let him deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me." **Matthew 16:24**
5. **How did God show His love to me?** But God proves his own love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. **Romans 5:8**
6. **Who lives in me?** I have been crucified with Christ, and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me. **Galatians 2:20**
7. **Who did Christ Jesus come to save?** This saying is trustworthy and deserving of full acceptance: "Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners" - and I am the worst of them. **1 Timothy 1:15**
8. **How can I resist the devil?** Therefore, submit to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. **James 4:7**
9. **How can I minister to others?** Just as each one has received a gift, use it to serve others, as good stewards of the varied grace of God. **1 Peter 4:10**
10. **Who is Jesus?** Whoever confesses that Jesus is the Son of God - God remains in him and he in God. **1 John 4:15**
